Piece Process Visualized Note: I used my phone as reference for the phones displayed here

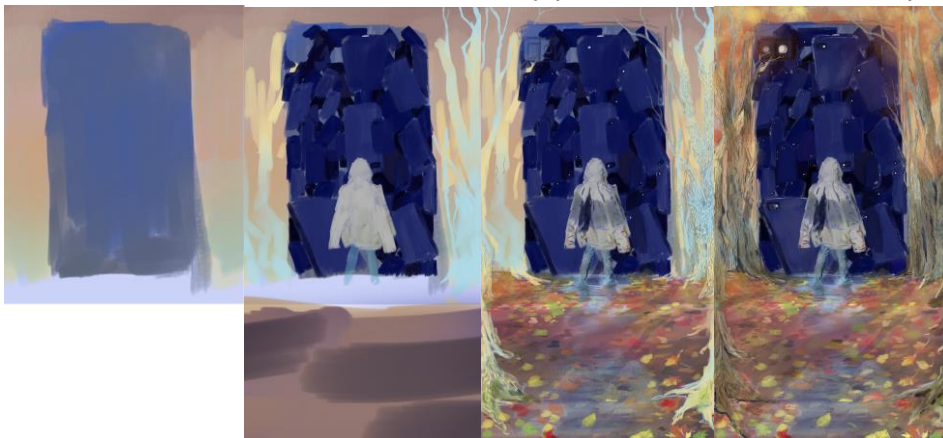
